These ESCAPES are privately guided for individuals, couples, families, and small groups. For groups larger than 8 participants, see our Custom Escapes and Group Programs webpage. Our one-day adventures are designed for folks who have had little or no experience in the recreational activity offered, although all levels are invited. The pace may be relaxed to allow time for skills instruction and exploring nature, or it may be as intense as your party wishes to cover more miles. The prices listed below are subject to change without notice, and please keep in mind flexible options are available to maximize your experience in New Hampshire. There may be additional fees for further customization—anything is possible.

For parties of one or two anglers, choose from White Mountains or Great North Woods Regions.
