Canoe and snowshoe as Native Abenaki American Indians did long ago from place to place each day, and enjoy the luxury, comfort, and company of a bed and breakfast and their innkeepers by afternoon. We also offer extended bicycle tours, Nordic skiing, and kayaking (from the Inuit) trips as well. All of these tours take you through New Hampshire's natural places, culture, and history. These inn-to-inn tours are for individuals, couples, families, and small groups. Prices are based on double occupancy and are subject to change due to customization. Lakes Region Inn-to-Inn **Paddle Tour**

Follow historic Native American Indian canoe routes in the Lake Winnipesaukee watershed and explore what today's local culture has to offer.

Your canoe or kayak tour starts in orchard country and you'll soon be among loons, herons, and the 274 or so islands on New Hampshire's largest lake. You'll see mountain views and shores lined with youth camps, vintage cottages, and new mansions. Each day you will paddle to another quaint village and your guide will take you to museums, nature centers, and the best ice cream shops in town. Includes fully guided trip with meals, kayaking, hiking, nature and history interpretation, cultural walks, lodging, luggage transport, and shuttle. During peak motorboat use in summer, canoeing and kayaking will take place early each day to avoid traffic and noise. May-Nov

Daily optional side trips, depending on the tour, may include: nature walk/hike, a visit into moose territory or tide pools, birding, kayaking, and swimming. Discover the deep woods of the Northern Forest in winter and you'll see signs of boreal wildlife (including moose and snowshoe hare), frozen mountain streams, and dark, starry skies. The fresh air is a great match for the exercise you'll be getting during your 2-10 miles a day of self-propelled wilderness travel, at your pace and duration. You will ski, snowshoe, or hike (depending on interests and trail conditions) to different types of lodging each night. Includes fully guided trip with meals, tours, ski instruction/tips, nature and history interpretation, lodging, luggage transport, and shuttle. You will travel on ungroomed logging roads, designated cross country ski trails, and wide snowmobile corridors. *Dec-Apr*
